DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

SAN FRANCISCO/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC **WEDNESDAY, MAY 8**

Begin your exciting journey as you depart from San Francisco on your overnight transatlantic flight to the Holy Land.

ARRIVE TEL AVIV

THURSDAY, MAY 9

Arrive in Tel Aviv today where you will be met and escorted to your waiting motor coach for the transfer to Netanya and your hotel. Your pilgrimage to the Land of the Bible begins. (D)

NETANYA/CAESAREA/MT. TABOR/TIBERIAS FRIDAY, MAY 10

Drive north today to Caesarea to view the ruins of the Crusader's fortress and moat and sit in the great Roman amphitheater. Continuing along the coast, you will see the aqueduct that carried water from Mt. Carmel to Caesarea. Ascend Mt. Tabor, to visit the church of the Transfiguration. Proceed to Tiberias for the night.



TIBERIAS

SATURDAY, MAY 11

Today, cross the Sea of Galilee on a boat cruise to Capernaum, center of Jesus' Ministry in the Galilee. Visit the ruins of the Second Century Synagoque. Drive to Magdala, home of Mary Magdalene. Here you will visit the Magdala center, containing the two-thousand-year-old Magdala stone in the chapel with an Altar in the shape of a fish-

ing boat. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the famous Sermon on the Mount and chose the Twelve Apostles. Return to Tiberias for the night.

TIBERIAS/CANA/NAZARETH/JERUSALEM **SUNDAY, MAY 12**

Drive to Cana, site of Jesus' first miracle of turning water into wine. Continue to Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus. Here you will visit the Church of the Annunciation and the winding streets of the old city. Proceed to Jerusalem and your hotel. (B,D)

JERUSALEM - THE DEAD SEA MONDAY, MAY 13

This morning drive into the Judean Desert, continuing to the Jordan River Valley and stop at the Jordan River, where it is believed that Our Lord was baptized by St. John the Baptist. Continue to the Dead Sea, situated 1412 feet below sea level. Believed to be the site of ancient Sodom and Gomorrah, enjoy free time here to wade in the water. On the east side of the Dead Sea are the Moab Mountains and Mt. Nebo where Moses viewed the Promised Land. Return to Jerusalem.



JERUSALEM - OLD CITY/MT. ZION TUESDAY, MAY 14

This morning, enjoy a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. Enter the Dung Gate and see the Wailing Wall. Continue to the Temple Area to see the Dome of the Rock and the El Aqsa Mosque. Visit St. Anne's Church and the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed the crippled man. Visit the Flagellation and Condemnation Chapels and the Roman Praetorium, beneath the Sisters of Zion Convent, and the Ecce Homo Arch. Follow in the footsteps of Jesus as you walk the Via Dolorosa, the traditional way of the Cross to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Exit the old city through the Zion Gate to Mt. Zion to visit the Upper Room, traditional site of the Last Supper. (B,D)

JERUSALEM - BETHLEHEM WEDNESDAY, MAY 15

Drive to the top of the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension and the Church of Pater Noster. Visit the Garden of Gethsemane and walk along the an-

cient olive trees, viewing the Kidron Valley. Drive to Bethlehem and have lunch at the Tent Restaurant. Next, visit the Church of the Nativity. See the Manger where Jesus was born and Shepherd's Field. Time to shop for wood carvings before returning to Jerusalem. and visit the Church of the Nativity.
